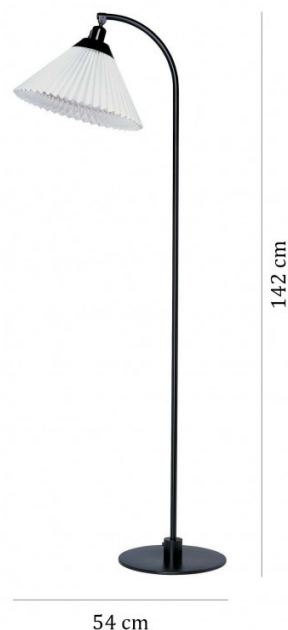

Le Klint 368 Floor Lamp

The 368 floor lamp was originally launched in 1979 at a fair in Gothenburg, Sweden. Designed by Flemming Agger for Le Klint, the 368 remains their best-selling floor lamp to date. The lamp combines Agger's aesthetic and Le Klint's hand-pleated shade to create a timeless and iconic design. Each shade is expertly folded at Le Klint's Pleating Studio in Odense, Denmark.

The beautifully arched metal stand and the folded lampshade are reminiscent of a tall flower, both appealing and delicate in form. The lampshade can be tilted, allowing you to guide the directional light to where it is needed. With a simplistic, monochromatic colour scheme, this floor lamp has a versatile design scheme that suits a range of interiors, both classic and contemporary. Place the 368 next to a sofa for a functional reading light that adds warm, diffused lighting to the room. The 368 floor lamp is available with a plastic foil shade or a paper shade. The plastic foil is fire-retardant and UV-resistant. The paper shade will patinate over time, developing a golden hue on its white colour.
