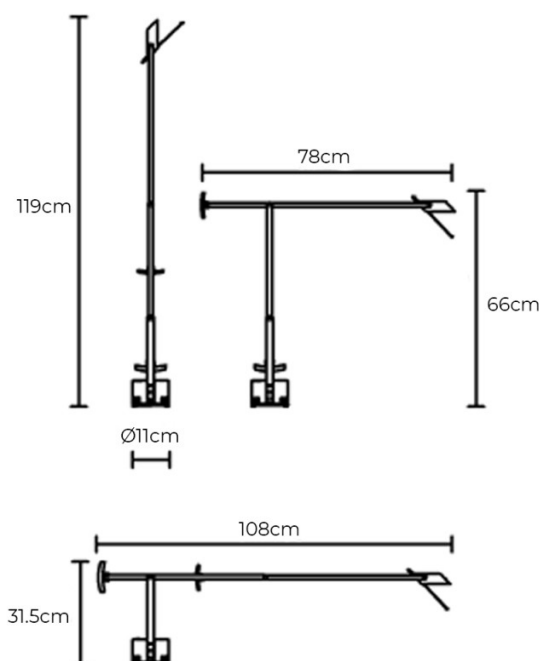

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Artemide's Tizio Table Lamp was designed in 1972 by Richard Sapper and has since become a classic design for the brand. An award-winning collection, the Tizio was one of the first table lights to incorporate a halogen lamp. Because of its unique design, no cables are required; the low-voltage current is simply carried along the conducting arms of the Tizio itself. With its striking minimalistic form, the counterbalance system ensures that Tizio is always in balance and can be set in almost any position, allowing you to easily direct the illumination to where it is needed most.

The Artemide Tizio Table Lamp comes in a black or white finish with adjustable counterbalanced arms and head in painted aluminium. The Tizio gives direct adjustable light; the white version is no longer dimmable, but the black finish is fitted with two light levels, which can be controlled via a button integrated onto the base of the lamp.
