Verpan Spiral SP2 Pendant

Designed by Verner Panton in 1969, the Spiral SP2 Pendant is an iconic expression of his experimental approach to design. Two clusters of metallic spirals are suspended from fine nylon strings, creating a weightless illusion, as if the pendant is floating in mid-air. Available in silver or gold finishes, the SP2 combines playful 1960s character with an elegant contemporary aesthetic, making it as much a work of art as it is a functional lighting solution.

When illuminated, the Spiral SP2 produces a soft, ambient, and pleasantly diffused glow. The spirals reflect and diffuse light to create subtle shadows and shimmering highlights throughout the pendant. Its generous size suits rooms with high ceilings, where it can be installed above a dining table, in an entrance hall, or as a focal point in hospitality and commercial spaces. The pendant's sculptural presence suits spacious, design-led settings complement the combination of light, movement, and reflection.

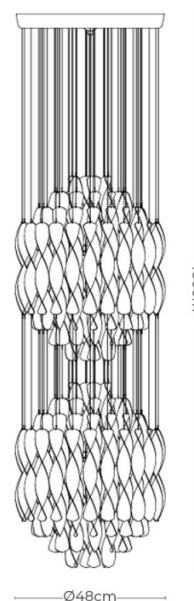
